III. SOME RESEARCH QUESTIONS

- How to trace the perimeter of «protected spaces?»
 - how to assess the degree of porousness of those boundaries?
 - does individual enhanced reflexivity mediate strategic behaviors?
 - do policy calls and mandates find an echo in individuals and institutions routines / strategies (does someone answer)?
 - in other words, do the linkages located at the meso level work?
- How to address the changing role of STS scholars?
 - how does integrated research relate to the futures of ELSA (Rip, 2009)?
 - Are STS scholars expected to provide a professional moral / ethic service?
 - Is the need for effectivity unavoidably driving STS towards politically engaged research?
